Services Provided

The health camps organized by PHC Narnoor covered a wide array of health services, aiming to address various health needs of the local population. The key services provided include:

1. Sickle Cell Screening:

o Detection and counseling for sickle cell anemia.

2. NCD (Non-Communicable Diseases) Screening:

 Comprehensive screenings for hypertension, diabetes, and other lifestyle-related diseases.

3. ABHA Card Generation:

 Facilitating the creation of Ayushman Bharat Health Account (ABHA) cards to enhance access to healthcare services.

4. TB Screening:

o Early detection and awareness programs for tuberculosis.

5. Eye Health Screening:

 Eye check-ups and provision of corrective measures for vision impairments.

6. Malaria/Dengue Testing:

 Diagnostic tests for malaria and dengue fever to ensure timely treatment.

7. Child Immunization:

o Immunizing children to protect them from various vaccinepreventable diseases.

8. Antenatal Care (ANC) Services:

 Ensuring that pregnant women receive all necessary ANC services, including regular check-ups and nutritional support.

9. Lifestyle Counseling:

o Counseling sessions to educate the community on lifestyle changes to prevent non-communicable diseases.

10. **Dental Health:**

o Dental check-ups and treatments to ensure oral health.

11. Lab Tests:

o A variety of laboratory tests to diagnose different health conditions.

Impact of the Health Camps

• Number of Beneficiaries:

- A large number of community members benefited from the services, including sickle cell screening, NCD screening, and TB screening.
